1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2777 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 2777 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Controlled Substances Act is 4 5 amended by adding Section 315.5 as follows: 6 (720 ILCS 570/315.5 new) 7 Sec. 315.5. Opioid education for prescribers. Every prescriber who is required under this Act to be registered to 8 prescribe controlled substances shall, during the pre-renewal 9 10 period, complete 3 hours of continuing education in safe opioid prescribing practices, which must include the following 11 12 subjects: Illinois and federal requirements for prescribing 13 controlled substances; appropriate prescribing; pain

management; prevention, screening, and signs of abuse and

addiction; and responses to abuse and addiction.

Notwithstanding anything that may appear in any individual

- licensing Act or administrative rule, a prescriber may count 1
- these 3 hours toward the total continuing education hours 2
- 3 required for renewal of professional licensure if the course is
- 4 presented by an approved continuing education provider. The
- 5 Department of Financial and Professional Regulation may adopt
- 6 rules for the administration of this Section.
- 7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 8 1, 2019.".
