2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 2952 on page 16, by  
3 replacing lines 5 through 15 with the following:

4 "(b) The Prescription Monitoring Program Advisory  
5 Committee shall consist of 16 members appointed by the Clinical  
6 Director of the Prescription Monitoring Program ~~The Clinical~~  
7 ~~Director of the Prescription Monitoring Program shall appoint~~  
8 ~~members to serve on the advisory committee. The advisory~~  
9 ~~committee shall be~~ composed of prescribers and dispensers  
10 licensed to practice in his or her respective profession as  
11 follows: one family or primary care physician; one pain  
12 specialist physician; 4 other physicians, one of whom may be an  
13 ophthalmologist ~~licensed to practice medicine in all its~~  
14 ~~branches; 2~~ one advanced practice registered nurses ~~nurse~~; one  
15 physician assistant; one optometrist; one dentist; ~~one~~  
16 ~~podiatric physician;~~ one veterinarian; one clinical  
17 representative from a statewide organization representing

1 on page 17, by replacing lines 1 and 2 with the following:

2 "2019 members shall draw lots for initial terms and 6 members  
3 shall serve 3 years, 5 members shall serve 2 years, and 5"; and

4 on page 17, by replacing lines 5 through 8 with the following:

5 "than 3 terms. The Clinical Director of the Prescription  
6 Monitoring Program may appoint a representative of an  
7 organization representing a profession required to be  
8 appointed. The Clinical Director of the Prescription"; and

9 on page 19, line 17, by deleting "or ophthalmologist".
