- 1 Teacher Program. Subject to any tuition waiver limitation established by the Board of Higher Education, a public 2 institution of higher education shall waive any tuition, fees, 3 4 and on-campus housing costs for a student who does all of the 5 following:
 - (1) Agrees to pursue a minimum of a bachelor's degree in agriculture, science, technology, engineering, or mathematics for a teaching occupation that includes, but is not limited to, mathematics, natural sciences, or career and vocational education in the areas of agriculture education teacher, technology teacher, industrial arts teacher, trade teacher, health care teacher, or information technology teacher.
 - (2) Agrees to attend a public institution of higher education to pursue an undergraduate degree or an advanced degree in one of the concentrations set forth under paragraph (1) of this Section.
 - (3) Maintains a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (or its equivalent) at all times.
 - (4) Agrees to fully reimburse the public institution of higher education for any waived tuition, fees, or costs if the student fails to teach at least 3 years at a high school located in this State or less than 5 years at a public institution of higher education or a public community college located in this State.

- Section 15. Funding. Funding for this Act shall come from 1
- the General Revenue Fund and shall be subject to ongoing 2
- 3 appropriation.
- Section 90. Rules. The Board of Higher Education shall 4
- adopt rules it determines are necessary for the administration 5
- of this Act. 6
- 7 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 2020.". 8
