1 The Child Protective Service Unit shall designate members 2 of each unit to receive specialty training to serve as special 3 consultants to unit staff and the public in the areas of child 4 sexual abuse, child deaths and injuries, and out-of-home 5 investigations.

6 If a child protective investigator of a Child Protective Service Unit is unable to obtain assistance from other unit 7 members when responding to a high-risk report of child abuse or 8 9 neglect and the child protective investigator has a reasonable 10 belief or suspicion that a subject named in the report has the potential for violence, the child protective investigator may 11 request assistance from local law enforcement officers to be 12 13 provided at a mutually available time. Law enforcement officers 14 shall, upon request, make all reasonable efforts to assist the 15 child protective investigator in receiving law enforcement assistance from any other police jurisdiction that is outside 16 the accompanying officers' primary jurisdiction. 17
