12 Section 15. The amounts appropriated for repairs and maintenance, and other capital improvements in Section 10 for 13 repairs and maintenance, roof repairs and/or replacements and 14 15 miscellaneous capital improvements at the Department's various 16 institutions are to include construction, reconstruction, improvements, repairs and installation of capital facilities, 17 18 costs of planning, supplies, materials and all other expenses 19 required for roof and other types of repairs and maintenance, 20 capital improvements, and purchase of land.

21 No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred 22 for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from 23 appropriations made in Section 10 of this Article until after SB3318 -8- OMB100 00188 PAP 10188 b 1 the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the 2 Governor.

3 Section 20. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may 4 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Juvenile 5 Justice from the General Revenue Fund for costs and expenses 6 associated with payment of statewide hospitalization.

Section 25. The amount of \$194,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Juvenile Justice for the purposes of investigating complaints, evaluating policies and procedures, and securing the rights of the youth committed to the Department of Juvenile Justice, including youth released on Aftercare before final discharge.

14 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 15 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary, 16 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all 17 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
