A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
7 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

14 Section 10. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Asset  
 16 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment  
 17 of their expenditures as outlined in the Illinois Drug Asset  
 18 Forfeiture Procedure Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the  
 19 Controlled Substances Act, and the Environmental Safety Act.

20 Section 15. The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as  
 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Asset  
 22 Forfeiture Fund to the Department of State Police for payment  
 23 of their expenditures in accordance with the Federal Equitable

1 Sharing Guidelines.

2 Section 20. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
4 Police, Division of Administration, from the Money Laundering  
5 Asset Recovery Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses  
6 incurred by the Department of State Police.

7 Section 25. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the LEADS Maintenance  
9 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of  
10 Administration, for expenses related to the LEADS System.

11 Section 30. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
13 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

18 Section 35. The following amount, or so much thereof as  
 19 may be necessary for objects and purposes hereinafter named,  
 20 are appropriated from the Drug Traffic Prevention Fund to the  
 21 Department of State Police, Division of Operations, pursuant  
 22 to the provisions of the "Intergovernmental Drug Laws  
 23 Enforcement Act" for Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups.

24 For Grants to Metropolitan Enforcement Groups:

1 Payable from the Drug Traffic  
 2 Prevention Fund .....500,000

3 Section 45. The sum of \$14,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police  
 5 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Department of  
 6 State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law  
 7 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State Whistleblower  
 8 Protection Act.

9 Section 50. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police  
 11 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police  
 12 for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the  
 13 Department of State Police.

14 Section 55. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may  
 15 be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Streetgang-  
 16 Related Crime Fund to the Department of State Police for  
 17 operations related to streetgang-related Crime Initiatives.

18 Section 60. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Over Dimensional  
 20 Load Police Escort Fund to the Department of State Police for  
 21 expenses incurred for providing police escorts for over-

1 dimensional loads.

2 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may  
3 be necessary, is appropriated from the Medicaid Fraud and Abuse  
4 Prevention Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of  
5 Operations for the detection, investigation or prosecution of  
6 recipient or vendor fraud.

7 Section 75. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the  
9 Department of State Police for the following purposes:

10 Section 80. The sum of \$2,250,000, or so much thereof as  
 11 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
 12 Police, Division of Forensic Services and Identification, from  
 13 the Mental Health Reporting Fund for expenses as outlined in  
 14 the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm Owners  
 15 Identification Card Act.

16 Section 85. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof  
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
 18 Police from the State Police Firearm Services Fund for expenses  
 19 as outlined in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm  
 20 Owners Identification Card Act.

21 Section 90. The following amounts, or so much thereof as  
 22 may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the

1 Department of State Police for Internal Investigation expenses  
2 as follows:

16 Section 95. The sum of \$717,900, or so much thereof as may  
17 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State  
18 Police, Division of Internal Investigation, from the General  
19 Revenue Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred  
20 while operating the Nursing Home Identified Offender Program.

21 Section 100. The sum of \$215,000,000, or so much thereof  
22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1  
23 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of

1 Administration, for costs pursuant to the Emergency Telephone  
2 System Act.

3 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July  
4 1, 2018. Notwithstanding anything in this Act to the contrary,  
5 appropriations authorized in this Act shall be used for all  
6 costs incurred prior to July 1, 2019.
