SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, It is highly fitting that the Illinois General 3 Assembly pays honor and respect to the truly great individuals 4 who have served our country and, in doing so, have made the 5 ultimate sacrifice for our nation; and

6 WHEREAS, The Gaultney brothers from LeRoy bravely served 7 their country during World War II and gave the ultimate 8 sacrifice; and

9 WHEREAS, Ralph Gaultney served in the U.S. Navy as a 10 gunners mate, third class; he was assigned to the U.S.S. 11 Arizona and was mortally wounded on December 7, 1941 during the 12 attack on Pearl Harbor; he died on December 24, 1941 in the 13 Navy Hospital at Pearl Harbor; and

14 WHEREAS, Leonard Gaultney also served in the U.S. Navy as a 15 machinist's mate first class; he was assigned to the heavy 16 cruiser U.S.S. Vincennes and died on August 9, 1942 when his 17 ship was sunk during the naval battle of the Solomon Islands, 18 Guadalcanal campaign; and

WHEREAS, David Gaultney served with the U.S. Marine Corps as a private first class; he was assigned to Company A, First Battalion, Third Division, Ninth Regiment and died on March 3, SJ0065 -2- LRB100 20933 MST 36507 r 1945 during the battle of Iwo Jima; therefore, be it
