Introduced 3/24/2017, by Sen. Chapin Rose

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. IV, Sec. 2.5 new

Proposes to amend the Legislature Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that a person may not be elected to the office of State Senator or State Representative for terms totalling more than 10 years in each house of the General Assembly. Provides that service before the second Wednesday in January of 2019 shall be considered in the calculation of a person's service. Effective upon being declared adopted.

14	SECTION 2.5. TERM LIMITS.
15	A person may not be elected to the office of State Senator
16	or State Representative for terms totalling more than 10 years
17	in each house of the General Assembly. Service before the
18	second Wednesday in January of 2019 shall be considered in the
19	calculation of a person's service.

21	This Constitutional Amendment takes effect upon being
22	declared adopted in accordance with Section 7 of the Illinois
