13 attorney Star Jones, financial expert Mellody Hobson,
14 comedian/actress Wanda Sykes, actress Jada Pinkett-Smith, Cook
15 County Recorder of Deeds Karen Yarbrough, Cook County Board
16 President Toni Preckwinkle, and the President of Liberia, Ellen
17 Johnson Sirleaf; and

18 WHEREAS, Many members of the General Assembly and
19 legislative staff are members of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority,
20 Inc., including Senate Majority Whip Mattie Hunter, Senator Toi
21 Hutchinson, India Hammons, and Nia Odeoti-Hassan, who has

15 vitality of the organization, and the sorority's continuing
16 requirements of academic excellence, shared values, and
17 dedication to the mission of Alpha Kappa Alpha ensure a
18 continuous wellspring of quality leaders; therefore, be it

20 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate the date
21 of May 10, 2017 as Alpha Kappa Alpha Day in the State of
22 Illinois in honor of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated,
