5 WHEREAS, The students and teachers should be recognized for 6 their efforts and their team spirit toward this notable 7 project; and

8 WHEREAS, With this project being a collaboration of 9 students, schools, and communities the teamwork and 10 cooperation demonstrated is noteworthy, exciting, and 11 significant in multiple forms; and

12 WHEREAS, The growth of our area, the beauty of our 13 environment, the strength of our communities, and the character 14 of our youth are all enhanced by the efforts and spirit of 15 these students; therefore, be it
