2	WHEREAS, The Presidential Advisory Commission on Election
3	Integrity was purportedly established by executive order to
4	investigate vulnerabilities in voting systems and practices
5	used for federal elections that could lead to improper voter
6	registrations and improper voting, including fraudulent voter
7	registrations and fraudulent voting; and

- 8 WHEREAS, President Donald Trump has consistently
  9 maintained, without evidence, that three to five million
  10 illegal votes were cast in the 2016 presidential election for
  11 the Democratic candidate, Hillary Clinton; and
- 12 WHEREAS, President Trump's Advisory Commission on Election 13 Integrity has requested the personal data and voting history of 14 every American voter; and
- 15 WHEREAS, It is the duty of the State Board of Elections to 16 ensure the integrity of our elections and to protect voting 17 rights and the privacy of Illinois voters; and
  - WHEREAS, Illinois law allows voter data to be obtained by political committees, which use it to develop their voter databases, and by governmental agencies for governmental purposes; however, Illinois law prohibits release of the more

- 1 personal information associated with voters, such as Social
- 2 Security numbers, driver's license numbers, and digital copies
- 3 of voter signatures; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDREDTH GENERAL

  ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the State Board of

  Elections is urged to decline any request to turn over or share
- 7 personal data or confidential voter registration data to the
- 8 Advisory Commission on Election Integrity; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 10 delivered to the President and Vice President of the United 11 States, United States Senator Richard Durbin, United States 12 Senator Tammy Duckworth, the entire Illinois Congressional 13 Delegation, Governor Rauner, and the Illinois State Board of
- 14 Elections.
