- 7 Sullivan, Decatur, Springfield, and Shelbyville before being
- 8 elected Resident Circuit Judge of Shelby County, 4th Judicial
- 9 Circuit in 2012; and

- 11 his parents, Leo and Donna Bennett; and his sister, Suzie
- 12 Rudin; and
