WHEREAS, Leonard Doyle worked at the Assembly Hall for 43 years and at Owens Funeral Home for over 20 years; he retired from Eisner-Jewel after 32 years of service and 17 years with the MTD; and

WHEREAS, Leonard Doyle's community involvement included 67 years at the Virginia Theatre; he was the co-founder of the Champaign Urbana Theatre Company (CUTC); for 65 years, he held numerous positions in the local and state councils of the Knights of Columbus and Squires; he was actively involved in the Champaign-Urbana Freedom Celebration for over 50 years; he also served as a Eucharistic Minister for Holy Cross Catholic Church for over 40 years; due to his love of people, he was never without a community project; and
