WHEREAS, Donna Kuhlman was born in Galesburg to Floyd and Doris Walker on June 2, 1938 and raised on a farm in Knox County; growing up, she was active in 4-H and won numerous county and state awards for sewing and cooking; she was awarded the 4-H Key Club Award for her outstanding projects and activities; she graduated from Western Illinois University with a Bachelor of Science in Home Economics and married Don Kuhlman in Galva on June 24, 1962; and

WHEREAS, Donna Kuhlman was employed as an Assistant Home Adviser in Adams County by the University of Illinois Cooperative Extension Service; she taught high school in Gillespie from 1961 to 1962; and

WHEREAS, Donna Kuhlman was an excellent cook and seamstress and judged sewing projects at the Illinois State Fair for several years; she also collected cookbooks and thousands of recipes and enjoyed preparing many delicious meals for her family and friends; she was outgoing and enjoyed helping others; she was an avid Illini football and basketball fan; she
