Amends the Code of Civil Procedure. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning commencement of actions and forms of process.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by changing Section 2-201 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/2-201) (from Ch. 110, par. 2-201)
- 7 Sec. 2-201. Commencement of actions Forms of process.
- 8 (a) Every action, unless otherwise expressly provided by
- 9 statute, shall be commenced by $\underline{\text{the}}$ filing of a complaint.
- 10 The clerk shall issue summons upon request of the plaintiff.
- 11 The form and substance of the summons, and of all other
- 12 process, and the issuance of alias process, and the service of
- copies of pleadings shall be according to rules.
- 14 (b) One or more duplicate original summonses may be issued,
- 15 marked "First Duplicate," "Second Duplicate," etc., as the case
- 16 may be, whenever it will facilitate the service of summons in
- any one or more counties, including the county of venue.
- 18 (c) A court's jurisdiction is not affected by a technical
- 19 error in format of a summons if the summons has been issued by
- 20 a clerk of the court, the person or entity to be served is
- 21 identified as a defendant on the summons, and the summons is
- 22 properly served. This subsection is declarative of existing
- 23 law.
