720 ILCS 5/33-5

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning preservation of evidence.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 33-5 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/33-5)
- 7 Sec. 33-5. Preservation of evidence.
- 8 (a) It is unlawful for a law enforcement agency or an agent
- 9 acting on behalf of the the law enforcement agency to
- intentionally fail to comply with the provisions of subsection
- 11 (a) of Section 116-4 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963.
- 12 (b) Sentence. A person who violates this Section is guilty
- of a Class 4 felony.
- 14 (c) For purposes of this Section, "law enforcement agency"
- 15 has the meaning ascribed to it in subsection (e) of Section
- 16 116-4 of the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963.
