1 to paragraph 6 of subsection (a) of Section 6-206 as the result 2 of refusal of chemical testing in another state, or any person 3 who has not had a driver's license suspension or revocation for 4 violating Section 11-501.1 within 10 $\frac{5}{2}$ years prior to the date 5 of the current offense, except in cases where the driver 6 submitted to chemical testing resulting in an alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more, or any amount of a drug, 7 substance, or compound in such person's blood, other bodily 8 9 substance, or urine resulting from the unlawful use or 10 consumption of cannabis listed in the Cannabis Control Act, a 11 controlled substance listed in the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, or an intoxicating compound listed in the Use 12 13 of Intoxicating Compounds Act, or methamphetamine as listed in 14 the Methamphetamine Control and Community Protection Act and 15 was subsequently found not guilty of violating Section 11-501, 16 or a similar provision of a local ordinance.
