Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Secretary of State shall provide electric vehicle registration plates specifically for persons with disabilities. Effective December 1, 2019.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 3-805 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-805) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-805)

7 Sec. 3-805. Electric vehicles. The owner of a motor vehicle of the first division or a motor vehicle of the second 8 9 division weighing 8,000 pounds or less propelled by an electric engine and not utilizing motor fuel, may register such vehicle 10 for a fee not to exceed \$35 for a 2-year registration period. 11 The Secretary may, in his discretion, prescribe that electric 12 vehicle registration plates be issued for an indefinite term, 13 14 such term to correspond to the term of registration plates issued generally, as provided in Section 3-414.1. The Secretary 15 16 shall provide electric vehicle registration plates for persons 17 with disabilities to applicants who meet the criteria of Section 3-609 or 3-616. In no event may the registration fee 18 for electric vehicles exceed \$18 per registration year. 19
