SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/19A-10

Amends the Election Code. Requires an election authority to provide a designated free parking location for the duration of early voting at any permanent polling place for early voting.

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AN ACT concerning election.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section
19A-10 as follows:

6 (10 ILCS 5/19A-10)

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Sec. 19A-10. Permanent polling places for early voting.

(a) An election authority may establish permanent polling 8 9 places for early voting by personal appearance at locations 10 throughout the election authority's jurisdiction, including but not limited to a municipal clerk's office, a township 11 clerk's office, a road district clerk's office, or a county or 12 local public agency office. Any person entitled to vote early 13 14 by personal appearance may do so at any polling place established for early voting. 15

16 (b) (Blank).

(c) During each general primary and general election, each election authority in a county with a population over 250,000 shall establish at least one permanent polling place for early voting by personal appearance at a location within each of the a largest municipalities within its jurisdiction. If any of the largest municipalities is over 80,000, the election authority shall establish at least 2 permanent polling places within the

1 municipality. All population figures shall be determined by the 2 federal census.

3 (d) During each general primary and general election, each 4 board of election commissioners established under Article 6 of 5 this Code in any city, village, or incorporated town with a 6 population over 100,000 shall establish at least 2 permanent 7 polling places for early voting by personal appearance. All 8 population figures shall be determined by the federal census.

9 (e) During each general primary and general election, each 10 election authority in a county with a population of over 11 100,000 but under 250,000 persons shall establish at least one 12 permanent polling place for early voting by personal 13 appearance. The location for early voting may be the election authority's main office or another location designated by the 14 election authority. The election authority may designate 15 16 additional sites for early voting by personal appearance. All 17 population figures shall be determined by the federal census.

(f) No permanent polling place required by this Section shall be located within 1.5 miles from another permanent polling place required by this Section, unless such permanent polling place is within a municipality with a population of 500,000 or more.

23 (g) An election authority shall provide a designated free
