SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

510 ILCS 70/2.01i new 510 ILCS 70/7.15

Amends the Humane Care for Animals Act. Provides that a person may not willfully and maliciously annoy, harass, taunt, injure, kill, or otherwise harm any animal (rather than a guide, hearing, or support dog) that provides assistance to a person with a disability. Sets forth penalties. Defines "assistance animal". Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning animals.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by 5 changing Section 7.15 and by adding Section 2.01i as follows:

- (510 ILCS 70/2.01i new) 6 7 Sec. 2.01i. Assistance animal. "Assistance animal" means an animal trained by a licensed or certified person, 8 9 organization, or agency to assist a person who has a physical, sensory, intellectual, developmental, psychiatric, or mental 10 disability in one or more daily life activities. "Assistance 11 animal" includes guide dogs, leader dogs, hearing ear dogs, and 12 any animal trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit 13 14 of a person with a disability, including, but not limited to: (1) pulling a wheelchair; 15 16 (2) providing balance or stability support; 17 (3) retrieving objects; and 18 (4) providing assistance and support during a medical, 19 psychological, or emotional crisis. 20 (510 ILCS 70/7.15) 21 Sec. 7.15. (a) A person may not willfully and maliciously annoy, 1 2 taunt, tease, harass, torment, beat, or strike an assistance animal a guide, hearing, or support dog or otherwise engage in 3 any conduct directed toward an assistance animal a guide, 4 5 hearing, or support dog that is likely to impede or interfere with the assistance animal's dog's performance of its duties or 6 that places the blind, hearing impaired, or person with a 7 physical disability being served or assisted by the assistance 8 9 animal dog in danger of injury.

10 (b) A person may not willfully and maliciously torture, 11 injure, or kill <u>an assistance animal</u> a guide, hearing, or 12 support dog.

(c) A person may not willfully and maliciously permit <u>an</u> animal <u>a dog</u> that is owned, harbored, or controlled by the person to cause injury to or the death of <u>an assistance animal</u> a <u>guide</u>, hearing, or support dog while the <u>assistance animal</u> guide, hearing, or support dog is in discharge of its duties.

(d) A person convicted of violating this Section is guilty 18 of a Class A misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation is a 19 20 Class 4 felony. A person convicted of violating subsection (b) or (c) of this Section is guilty of a Class 4 felony if the 21 22 assistance animal dog is killed or totally disabled, and may be 23 ordered by the court to make restitution to the person with a disability having custody or ownership of the assistance animal 24 25 dog for veterinary bills and replacement costs of the 26 assistance animal dog.
