SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 45/2-218 new

Amends the Nursing Home Care Act. Requires facilities licensed under the Act to publish a record of all Type "AA", Type "A", and Type "B" violations of the facility received from the Department of Public Health for a period of no less than 5 years prior to the amendatory Act's effective date. Provides that the record must be published prominently on the facility's website. Provides disciplinary action for violation of the requirements.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Nursing Home Care Act is amended by adding
Section 2-218 as follows:

6	(210 ILCS 45/2-218 new)
7	Sec. 2-218. Publishing records of violations.
8	(a) A facility shall publish a record of all Type "AA",
9	Type "A", and Type "B" violations of the facility received from
10	the Department for a period of no less than 5 years prior to
11	the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General
12	Assembly. The record must be published prominently on the
13	facility's website either on:
14	(1) the homepage; or
15	(2) a secondary page accessed from a prominent menu
16	option entitled "IDPH violations" at the top of the
17	website's homepage.
18	(b) A violation of this Section shall result in the
19	following disciplinary action:
20	(1) For a first violation, a civil penalty of up to
21	<u>\$10,000.</u>
22	(2) For a second violation, a civil penalty of up to
23	<u>\$25,000.</u>

1	(3) For a third	or subsequent violation, a civil
2	penalty of up to \$50,	000, or suspension or revocation of
3	the facility's license	e under this Act, or both.
