2 WHEREAS, First responders are some of our most valuable 3 public servants; they protect both the community and residents 4 in the State on a daily basis and can face tremendous pressure from the events in which they are involved; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Suicide is a leading cause of death in the United 7 States and first responders are at a greater risk for suicide 8 due to the nature of their work; and 9 WHEREAS, The State has an obligation to protect those who 10 dedicate themselves to protecting its residents; therefore, be 11 it. 12 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE 13 HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that there is created the First Responders Suicide Task Force to pursue recommendations to help reduce the risk and rates of suicide among first responders; and be it further

- (3) Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, one of whom will serve as Co-Chair;
- (4) Two members of the House of Representatives appointed by the House Minority Leader;
- (5) Two members of the Senate appointed by the Senate President, one of whom will serve as Co-Chair;
- (6) Two members of the Senate appointed by the Senate Minority Leader;
- (7) Two members who represent two different mental health organizations, one appointed by the minority leader of the House and one appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- (8) One member who represents an organization that advocates on behalf of police appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- (9) One member who represents the Chicago Police Department appointed by the House Minority Leader;
- (10) Two members who represent organizations that advocate on behalf of firefighters appointed by the Senate President;
- (11) One member who represents the Chicago Fire Department appointed by the Senate Minority Leader;
  - (12) One member who represents an organization that

- 1 advocates on behalf of sheriffs in the State of Illinois
- 2 appointed by the Speaker of the House; and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That members of the Task Force shall be appointed
- 4 within 30 days after passage of this resolution and shall serve
- 5 without compensation; and be it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall commence meeting as
- 7 soon as possible; and be it further
- 8 RESOLVED, That the Illinois State Police shall provide
- 9 administrative support for the Task Force, and if the subject
- 10 matter is either sensitive or classified, the Task Force may
- 11 hold the hearings in private; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Task Force shall issue a final report to
- the General Assembly by January 1, 2020 and, upon the filing of
- its report, is dissolved; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 16 delivered to the above mentioned elected and appointed
- 17 authorities.
