SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

405 ILCS 5/3-802

from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 3-802

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code. Provides that when the respondent requests a jury on the question of whether he or she is subject to involuntary admission on an inpatient or outpatient basis, the jury shall consist of 6 persons, unless either party demands a jury of 12 persons. Provides that a respondent is also entitled (rather than not entitled) to a jury on the question of whether psychotropic medication or electroconvulsive therapy may be administered under the Code. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
5 Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 3-802 as
6 follows:

7 (405 ILCS 5/3-802) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 3-802)

8 Sec. 3-802. The respondent is entitled to a jury on the
9 question of whether he or she is subject to involuntary
10 admission on an inpatient or outpatient basis. The jury shall
11 consist of 6 persons, unless either party demands a jury of 12
12 persons, to be chosen in the same manner as are jurors in other
13 civil proceedings. A respondent is also ~~not~~ entitled to a jury
14 on the question of whether psychotropic medication or
15 electroconvulsive therapy may be administered under Section
16 2-107.1.
