- Section 5. The Illinois Act on the Aging is amended by changing Section 3 and by adding Section 3.11 as follows:

- Sec. 3.11. Greatest social need. For the purposes of 89
- 13 Ill. Adm. Code 210.50, "greatest social need" means the need
- 14 <u>caused by noneconomic factors that restrict an individual's</u>
- ability to perform normal daily tasks or that threaten his or
- 16 her capacity to live independently. These factors include
- 17 physical or mental disability, language barriers, and cultural
- or social isolation caused by, among other things, racial and
- 19 ethnic status, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender
- 20 expression, or HIV status.
- 21 Section 10. The Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act is

- Sec. 97. Unlawful discrimination. No resident shall be 3
- subjected to unlawful discrimination as defined in Section 4
- 1-103 of the Illinois Human Rights Act by any owner, licensee, 5
- administrator, employee, or agent of an assisted living 6
- establishment. Unlawful discrimination does not include an 7
- action by any owner, licensee, administrator, employee, or 8
- agent of an assisted living establishment that is required by 9
- 10 this Act or rules adopted under this Act.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 11
