## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Sections 7-42 and 17-15 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/7-42) (from Ch. 46, par. 7-42)
- 7 Sec. 7-42.
- 8 (a) Any person entitled to vote at such primary shall, on
  9 the day of such primary, with the consent of his employer be
  10 entitled to absent himself from any service or employment in
  11 which he is then engaged or employed for a period of two hours
  12 between the time of opening and closing the polls. The employer
- 13 may specify the hours during which said employe may absent
- 14 himself.
- 15 (b) Beginning the 15th day before the primary election or
- on the day of the primary election, any student entitled to
- 17 vote at such primary shall be entitled to be absent from school
- for a period of 2 hours during the school day in order to vote.
- 19 The school may specify the hours during which the eligible
- 20 student may be absent. A student who is absent from school
- 21 under this subsection (b) is not considered absent for the
- 22 purpose of calculating enrollment under Section 18-8.15 of the
- 23 School Code.

- 4 (a) Any person entitled to vote at a general or special 5 election or at any election at which propositions are submitted 6 to a popular vote in this State, shall, on the day of such election, be entitled to absent himself from any services or 7 8 employment in which he is then engaged or employed, for a 9 period of 2 hours between the time of opening and closing the 10 polls; and such voter shall not because of so absenting himself 11 be liable to any penalty; Provided, however, that application 12 for such leave of absence shall be made prior to the day of 1.3 election. The employer may specify the hours during which said employee may absent himself as aforesaid, except that the 14 employer must permit a 2-hour absence during working hours if 15 16 the employee's working hours begin less than 2 hours after the opening of the polls and end less than 2 hours before the 17 18 closing of the polls. No person or corporation shall refuse to an employee the privilege hereby conferred, nor shall subject 19 an employee to a penalty, including a reduction in compensation 20 21 due to an absence under this Section, because of the exercise 22 of such privilege, nor shall directly or indirectly violate the provisions of this Section. 23
  - (b) Beginning the 15th day before a general or special election or any election at which propositions are submitted to

a popular vote in this State or on the day of a general or special election or any election at which propositions are submitted to a popular vote in this State, any student entitled to vote at such election shall be entitled to be absent from school for a period of 2 hours during the school day in order to vote. The school may specify the hours during which the eliqible student may be absent. A student who is absent from school under this subsection (b) is not considered absent for the purpose of calculating enrollment under Section 18-8.15 of
