

101ST GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2019 and 2020 SB2773

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-12022 new 60 ILCS 1/110-17 new 65 ILCS 5/11-13-28 new

Amends the Counties Code, Township Code, and Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a disabled veteran or his or her caregiver shall not be charged any building permit fee for improvements to the residence of the disabled veteran if the improvements are required to accommodate a service-connected disability. Provides that required paperwork to obtain a building permit shall still be submitted. Limits home rule powers. Effective January 1, 2021.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section 5-12022 as follows:

- Sec. 110-17. Disabled veteran building permit fee. A disabled veteran or his or her caregiver shall not be charged any building permit fee for improvements to the residence of the disabled veteran if the improvements are required to accommodate a service-connected disability. Nothing in this Section removes the responsibility to submit required paperwork to the township in order to obtain a building permit.
- 9 Section 15. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 10 adding Section 11-13-28 as follows:

- 12 Sec. 11-13-28. Disabled veteran building permit fee.
- (a) A disabled veteran or his or her caregiver shall not be

 charged any building permit fee for improvements to the
