"Law Enforcement Officials" means the Illinois StatePolice or any duly authorized employees of a local governmental

agency who are primarily responsible for prevention or detection of crime and enforcement of the criminal code and the highway and traffic laws of this State or any political subdivision of such State;

5 <u>"Local road" means any State roadway except for: (i) a</u> 6 highway with 4 or more lanes, or (ii) an interstate highway.

7 "Person" means any natural person or individual, 8 governmental body, firm, association, partnership, 9 copartnership, joint venture, company, corporation, joint 10 stock company, trust, estate or any other legal entity or their 11 legal representative, agent or assigns;

12 "Transports" or "transportation" means any movement of 13 property over the highway and any loading, unloading or storage 14 incidental to such movement.
