Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section

- Sec. 34-18.82. Subsequent teaching endorsements for
- 8 <u>employees.</u>

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- 9 <u>(a) Subsequent teaching endorsements may be granted to</u>
 10 <u>employees licensed under Article 21B of this Code for specific</u>
 11 content areas and grade levels as part of a pilot program.
- 12 <u>(b) The school district is authorized to prepare educators</u>
 13 for subsequent teaching endorsements on licenses issued under
- 15 meet all of the requirements for the endorsement or

paragraph (1) of Section 21B-20 of this Code to applicants who

- 16 <u>endorsements</u>, including passing any required content area
- 17 <u>knowledge</u> tests. If seeking to provide subsequent
