Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, as follows:

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the ordinary and  
8 contingent expenses of the Law Enforcement Training Standards  
9 Board:

10 OPERATIONS

11 Payable from the General Revenue Fund:

5 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof  
 6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes  
 7 hereinafter named, is appropriated to the Law Enforcement  
 8 Training Standards Board as follows:

9 GRANTS-IN-AID

10 Payable from the Traffic and Criminal  
 11 Conviction Surcharge Fund:  
 12 For payment of and/or reimbursement  
 13 of basic training and basic training services  
 14 in accordance with statutory provisions .....10,290,000  
 15 For payment of and/or reimbursement  
 16 of in-service training and in-service training services  
 17 in accordance with statutory provisions .....17,220,000

18 Section 15. The sum of \$8,000,000, or so much thereof as  
 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Law Enforcement  
 20 Officers Training Board Federal Projects Fund to the Law  
 21 Enforcement Training Standards Board for expenses relating to  
 22 various federal projects

1           Section 20. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof  
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
3 Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for  
4 deposit into the Law Enforcement Recruitment and Retention Fund  
5 for grants and administrative expenses to hire or retain law  
6 enforcement officers pursuant to Public Act 102-755.

7           Section 25. The amount of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Law Enforcement  
9 Recruitment and Retention Fund to the Law Enforcement Training  
10 Standards Board for grants and administrative expenses to hire  
11 or retain law enforcement officers pursuant to Public Act 102-  
12 755

13           Section 30. The amount of \$30,000,000, or so much thereof  
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
15 Fund to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for  
16 deposit into the Law Enforcement Camera Grant Fund.

17           Section 35. The amount of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof  
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund  
19 to the Law Enforcement Training Standards Board for grants to  
20 local law enforcement agencies for costs associated with the  
21 expansion and support of National Integrated Ballistics  
22 Information Network (NIBIN) and other ballistic technology

1 equipment for ballistic testing.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
3 2023.
