

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 HB4504

Introduced 1/31/2024, by Rep. Laura Faver Dias

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/356z.71 new

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that a health plan shall limit the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for a covered prescription inhaler at an amount not to exceed \$25 per 30-day supply and shall limit the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for all covered prescription inhalers at an amount not to exceed \$50 in total per 30 days. Provides that coverage for prescription inhalers shall not be subject to any deductible. Provides that nothing in the provisions prevents a health plan from reducing a covered person's cost sharing to an amount less than the cap. Authorizes rulemaking and enforcement by the Department of Insurance. Effective January 1, 2025.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by adding Section 356z.71 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.71 new)
- 7 Sec. 356z.71. Prescription inhalers.
- 8 (a) In this Section:
- 9 <u>"Health plan" means a policy of accident and health</u>
  10 <u>insurance or managed care plan that is amended, delivered,</u>
- issued, or renewed on or after the effective date of this
- 12 <u>amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly that provides</u>
- 13 coverage for prescription inhalers.
- 14 <u>"Prescription inhaler" means a prescribed medical device</u>
- that delivers inhaled medications used to treat respiratory
- 16 <u>conditions</u> and the <u>prescribed</u> inhaled <u>medication</u>.
- 17 <u>"Prescription inhaler" includes metered-dose inhalers,</u>
- 18 <u>nebulizers</u>, and dry powder inhalers. "Prescription inhaler"
- 19 <u>does not include inhalers available over the counter without a</u>
- 20 prescription to provide temporary relief from respiratory
- 21 <u>symptoms.</u>
- 22 (b) A health plan shall limit the total amount that a
- 23 <u>covered person is required to pay for a covered prescription</u>

- inhaler to an amount not to exceed \$25 per 30-day supply and
- 2 shall limit the total amount that a covered person is required
- 3 to pay for all covered prescription inhalers to an amount not
- 4 to exceed \$50 in total per 30 days. Coverage for prescription
- 5 inhalers shall not be subject to any deductible.
- 6 (c) Nothing in this Section prevents a health plan from
- 7 reducing a covered person's cost sharing to an amount less
- 8 than the amount specified in subsection (b).
- 9 <u>(d) The Department may adopt rules necessary to implement</u>
- 10 and administer this Section and to align with federal
- 11 requirements. The Department may use any of its enforcement
- powers to obtain a health plan's compliance with this Section.
- 13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 14 1, 2025.
