## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 5 changing Section 356z.56 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.56)

7 Sec. 356z.56. Coverage for hormonal and non-hormonal 8 hormone therapy to treat menopause. A group or individual 9 policy of accident and health insurance or a managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed in this State 10 on or after January 1, 2024 shall provide coverage for 11 12 medically necessary hormone therapy treatment to treat menopause that has been induced by a hysterectomy. This 13 14 coverage applies only to coverage provided on or after January 1, 2024 and before January 1, 2026. 15

16 A group or individual policy of accident and health 17 insurance or a managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026 shall provide 18 19 coverage for medically necessary hormonal and non-hormonal 20 therapy to treat menopausal symptoms if the therapy is 21 recommended by a qualified health care provider who is 22 licensed, accredited, or certified under Illinois law and the therapy has been proven safe and effective in peer-reviewed 23

scientific studies. Coverage for therapy to treat menopausal
symptoms shall include all federal Food and Drug
Administration-approved modalities of hormonal and
non-hormonal administration, including, but not limited to,
oral, transdermal, topical, and vaginal rings.

Section 10. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
changing Section 5-16.8 and by adding Section 5-52 as follows:

10 5-16.8. Required health benefits. The medical Sec. 11 assistance program shall (i) provide the post-mastectomy care benefits required to be covered by a policy of accident and 12 health insurance under Section 356t and the coverage required 13 14 under Sections 356g.5, 356g, 356u, 356w, 356x, 356z.6, 15 356z.26, 356z.29, 356z.32, 356z.33, 356z.34, 356z.35, 356z.46, 356z.47, 356z.51, 356z.53, <del>356z.56,</del> 356z.59, 356z.60, and 16 356z.61, 356z.64, and 356z.67 of the Illinois Insurance Code, 17 (ii) be subject to the provisions of Sections 356z.19, 18 356z.44, 356z.49, 364.01, 370c, and 370c.1 of the Illinois 19 20 Insurance Code, and (iii) be subject to the provisions of 21 subsection (d-5) of Section 10 of the Network Adequacy and 22 Transparency Act.

On and after July 1, 2012, the Department shall reduce any rate of reimbursement for services or other payments or alter any methodologies authorized by this Code to reduce any rate of reimbursement for services or other payments in accordance with Section 5-5e.

7 To ensure full access to the benefits set forth in this 8 Section, on and after January 1, 2016, the Department shall 9 ensure that provider and hospital reimbursement for 10 post-mastectomy care benefits required under this Section are 11 no lower than the Medicare reimbursement rate.

19 <u>Sec. 5-52. Coverage for hormonal therapy to treat</u> 20 <u>menopause. The medical assistance program shall provide</u> 21 <u>coverage for medically necessary hormone therapy treatment to</u> 22 <u>treat menopause that has been induced by a hysterectomy.</u>

23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January24 1, 2026.
