SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

235 ILCS 5/6-40 new

Amends the Liquor Control Act of 1934. Provides that a retail licensee may not sell alcoholic liquor for off-premises consumption at a price that exceeds 125% of the manufacturer's suggested retail price. Excludes auction liquor licensees from the provisions.

- 7 <u>Sec. 6-40. Price limitation.</u>
- 8 (a) A retail licensee may not sell alcoholic liquor for
- 9 off-premises consumption at a price that exceeds 125% of the
- 10 manufacturer's suggested retail price.
- 11 (b) This Section does not apply to an auction liquor
- 12 licensee selling alcoholic liquor at auction.
