2 WHEREAS, May is annually recognized as National Foster 3 Care Awareness Month to highlight the needs of children living 4 in foster care and the contributions that foster parents make 5 to society by opening their homes to children in need; and

6 WHEREAS, There are almost 21,000 children living in foster 7 care in the State of Illinois; and

8 WHEREAS, Children in foster care come from different 9 backgrounds, with many of them accompanied by brothers and 10 sisters; they need the comfort, support, and security that 11 only a family can provide; and

WHEREAS, Foster parents are the frontline caregivers for children who cannot safely remain with their parents, and they provide physical care, emotional support, and education advocacy; and

WHEREAS, An increased emphasis on prevention and reunification services is necessary to reduce the number of children that are forced to remain in the foster care system; and

20 WHEREAS, Children who age out of foster care often lack

- 1 the security or support necessary to secure affordable
- 2 housing, obtain health insurance, pursue higher education, and
- 3 acquire adequate employment; and
- WHEREAS, Illinois is strongly committed to ensuring that
- 5 children grow up healthy and safe in supportive homes and
- 6 families; therefore, be it

- 9 we recognize the month of May 2023 as National Foster Care
