1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 991

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 991 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section  
5 2-3.196 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.196 new)

7 Sec. 2-3.196. Employing manufacturing employees. Subject  
8 to appropriation, the State Board of Education shall pay  
9 one-half of the salary of an employee that is employed by a  
10 manufacturing company and working within a school district at  
11 a high school as a licensed career and technical education  
12 teacher.

13 The school board of a school district that intends to hire  
14 a manufacturing employee under this Section shall first notify  
15 any labor organization that has entered into a collective  
16 bargaining agreement with the school district of the school

1 board's intent to hire such an employee. If there are eligible  
2 employees in the applicable bargaining unit, then the school  
3 board shall offer to hire an employee who is a member of the  
4 applicable bargaining unit. If there are no eligible employees  
5 in the applicable bargaining unit, then the labor organization  
6 shall notify the school district and affirm that the position  
7 is unable to be filled by any members of the applicable  
8 bargaining unit."
