SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/34-4

from Ch. 122, par. 34-4

Amends the School Code. Authorizes the Chicago Board of Education, by resolution, to provide for the compensation of its members.

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AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
34-4 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/34-4) (from Ch. 122, par. 34-4)

Sec. 34-4. Eligibility. To be eligible for election or 7 8 appointment to the board, a person shall be a citizen of the 9 United States, shall be a registered voter as provided in the Election Code, shall have been a resident of the city and, if 10 applicable, the electoral district, for at least one year 11 immediately preceding his or her election or appointment, and 12 shall not be a child sex offender as defined in Section 11-9.3 13 14 of the Criminal Code of 2012. A person is ineligible for election or appointment to the board if that person is an 15 16 employee of the school district. All persons eligible for election to the board shall be nominated by a petition signed 17 by no less than 250 voters residing within the electoral 18 19 district on a petition in order to be placed on the ballot, 20 except that persons eligible for election to the board at 21 large shall be nominated by a petition signed by no less than 22 2,500 voters residing within the city. Permanent removal from the city by any member of the board during his term of office 23

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constitutes a resignation therefrom and creates a vacancy in 1 2 the board. The board may, by resolution, provide for the compensation of board members. The compensation provided for 3 board members may include, but is not limited to, 4 5 reimbursement Board members shall serve without any 6 compensation; however, board members shall be reimbursed for 7 expenses incurred while in the performance of their duties 8 upon submission of proper receipts or upon submission of a 9 signed voucher in the case of an expense allowance evidencing 10 the amount of such reimbursement or allowance to the president 11 of the board for verification and approval. Board members 12 shall not hold other public office under the Federal, State or 13 any local government other than that of Director of the 14 Regional Transportation Authority, member of the economic 15 development commission of a city having a population exceeding 16 500,000, notary public or member of the National Guard, and by 17 accepting any such office while members of the board, or by not resigning any such office held at the time of being elected or 18 19 appointed to the board within 30 days after such election or 20 appointment, shall be deemed to have vacated their membership in the board. 21
