

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 SB2636

Introduced 11/6/2023, by Sen. Christopher Belt

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-35

Amends the Medical Assistance Article of the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that for a person who is a resident of a supportive living facility, the State shall pay an amount in addition to the minimum monthly personal needs allowance authorized under the Social Security Act so that the person's total monthly personal needs allowance from both the State and federal sources equals \$120.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by changing Section 5-35 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-35)
- 7 Sec. 5-35. Personal needs allowance. For a person who is a 8 resident in a facility licensed under the ID/DD Community Care 9 Act, the Community-Integrated Living Arrangements Licensure Specialized Mental Certification Act, the 10 Rehabilitation Act of 2013, or the MC/DD Act for whom payments 11 are made under this Article throughout a month and who is 12 determined to be eligible for medical assistance under this 13 14 Article, the State shall pay an amount in addition to the minimum monthly personal needs allowance authorized under 15 16 Section 1902(q) of Title XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(q)) so that the person's total monthly personal 17 needs allowance from both State and federal sources equals 18 19 \$60.
- For a person who is a resident of a supportive living

  facility as described in Section 5-5.01a, the State shall pay

  an amount in addition to the minimum monthly personal needs

  allowance authorized under Section 1902(q) of Title XIX of the

- Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(q)) so that the person's
- 2 total monthly personal needs allowance from both State and
- 3 <u>federal sources equals \$120.</u>
