Sec. 3.21. Hospital first responders. The General 7 Assembly finds that in the event of terrorist acts, 8 especially those involving the release of biological agents, 9 bacteria, viruses, or other agents intended to cause illness 10 or injury, hospitals serve as first responders in diagnosing 11 12 and treating the victims of those acts. As first responders, hospitals are on the front lines of the State's emergency 13 14 management efforts. Given the increased demands for equipment, materials, and training associated with their 15 responsibility as first responders in the event of terrorist 16 acts, hospitals would benefit from additional resources to 17 enable them to be better prepared to protect and aid the 18 residents of the State. In awarding funds to support disaster 19 preparedness by first responders, the Department and any 20 other State agencies shall take into account the role of 21 hospitals in being prepared to respond to emergencies or 22

- 1 <u>disasters.</u>".
