age or older who has at least one year of driving

3 (4) When issuing an instruction permit under 4 paragraph (1) of this subsection (a) for a vehicle other 5 than a motorcycle, the Secretary of State may, subject to 6 appropriation, also make available to the applicant a 7 sign with the words "Student Driver" printed on it. The 8 Secretary shall adopt rules for implementing this 9 paragraph (4).

10 (a-1) The sign issued under this Section may be 11 displayed on the rear of a vehicle other than a motorcycle in 12 a clearly visible location whenever the holder of the 13 instruction permit is driving the vehicle.

(b) An instruction permit issued under this Section when issued to a person under the age of 17 years shall, as a matter of law, be invalid for the operation of any motor vehicle during the same time the child is prohibited from being on any street or highway under the provisions of the Child Curfew Act.

20 (c) Any person under the age of 16 years who possesses 21 an instruction permit and whose driving privileges have been 22 suspended or revoked under the provisions of this Code shall 23 not be granted a Family Financial Responsibility Driving 24 Permit or a Restricted Driving Permit.
