

1 AN ACT concerning higher education appropriations.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
5 Section 13.5 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 105/13.5 new)

7 Sec. 13.5. Appropriations for higher education. State
8 appropriations to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois
9 University, the Board of Trustees of the University of
10 Illinois, the Board of Trustees of Chicago State University,
11 the Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University, the
12 Board of Trustees of Illinois State University, the Board of
13 Trustees of Governors State University, the Board of Trustees
14 of Northeastern Illinois University, the Board of Trustees of
15 Northern Illinois University, and the Board of Trustees of
16 Western Illinois University for operations shall identify the
17 amounts appropriated for personal services, State
18 contributions to social security for Medicare, contractual
19 services, travel, commodities, equipment, operation of
20 automotive equipment, telecommunications, awards and grants,
21 and permanent improvements.

22 Within 120 days after the conclusion of each fiscal year,
23 each State-supported institution of higher learning must
24 provide, through the Illinois Board of Higher Education, a
25 financial report to the Governor and General Assembly
26 documenting the institution's revenues and expenditures of
27 funds for that fiscal year ending June 30 for all funds.

28 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
29 becoming law.
