- 1 AN ACT concerning environmental protection.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended
- 5 by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (415 ILCS 5/8) (from Ch. 111 1/2, par. 1008)
- 7 Sec. 8. <u>Legislative findings</u>. The General Assembly
- 8 finds that pollution of the air of this State constitutes a
- 9 menace to public health and welfare, creates public
- 10 nuisances, adds to cleaning costs, accelerates the
- 11 deterioration of materials, adversely affects agriculture,
- 12 business, industry, recreation, climate, and visibility,
- depresses property values, and offends the senses.
- 14 It is the purpose of this Title to restore, maintain, and
- 15 enhance the purity of the air of this State in order to
- 16 protect health, welfare, property, and the quality of life
- 17 and to assure that no air contaminants are discharged into
- 18 the atmosphere without being given the degree of treatment or
- 19 control necessary to prevent pollution.
