### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/12-6.4 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of criminal street gang recruitment on school grounds. Provides that a person commits the offense when on school grounds he or she threatens the use of physical force to coerce, solicit, recruit, or induce another person to join or remain a member of a criminal street gang, or conspires to do so. Provides that criminal street gang recruitment on school grounds is a Class 4 felony.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
Section 12-6.4 as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/12-6.4 new)

7 <u>Sec. 12-6.4. Criminal street gang recruitment on school</u> 8 grounds.

9 <u>(a) A person commits the offense of criminal street gang</u> 10 <u>recruitment on school grounds when on school grounds, he or she</u> 11 <u>threatens the use of physical force to coerce, solicit,</u> 12 <u>recruit, or induce another person to join or remain a member of</u> 13 <u>a criminal street gang, or conspires to do so.</u>

14 (b) Sentence. Criminal street gang recruitment on school 15 grounds is a Class 4 felony.

16 <u>(c) In this Section, "criminal street gang" has the meaning</u> 17 <u>ascribed to it in Section 10 of the Illinois Streetgang</u> 18 <u>Terrorism Omnibus Prevention Act and "school grounds" means the</u> 19 <u>building or buildings or real property comprising a public or</u> 20 <u>private elementary or secondary school, community college,</u> 21 <u>college, or university.</u>
