AN ACT in relation to public health.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Lead Poisoning Prevention Act is amended by
changing Section 3 as follows:

Sec. 3. Lead bearing substance use. No person shall use orapply lead bearing substances:

9 (a) In or upon any exposed surface of a dwelling or 10 dwelling unit;

11 (b) In or around the exposed surfaces of a child care 12 facility or other structure frequented by children;

(c) In or upon any fixtures or other objects used, installed, or located in or upon any exposed surface of a dwelling or residential building, or child care facility, or intended to be <del>so</del> used, installed, or located and that, in the ordinary course of use, are accessible to and chewable by children;

(d) In or upon any toys, furniture, or other articles usedby and chewable by children;

(e) Within or upon a residential building or dwelling,
child care facility, school, playground, park, or recreational
area, or other areas regularly frequented by children.
