- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2-3.61a as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.61a new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2-3.61a. 21st Century Community Learning Center</u>
- 8 Grant Program.
- 9 (a) The State Board of Education shall be the designated
- 10 <u>agency responsible for the administration of programs under</u>
- 11 Part I of Subchapter X of Chapter 70 of the federal
- 12 <u>Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.</u>
- 13 (b) The State Board of Education shall establish and
- 14 <u>implement a 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant</u>
- 15 Program, in accordance with federal guidelines, to provide
- 16 grants to support academically focused after-school programs
- for students who attend high-poverty, low-performing schools.
- 18 These grants shall be used to help those students who attend
- 19 <u>high-poverty</u>, <u>low-performing schools meet State and local</u>
- 20 <u>performance standards in core academic subjects and to offer</u>
