- 2 AMENDMENT NO. ____. Amend Senate Bill 1147, AS AMENDED,
- 3 in Section 5, by replacing the introductory clause with the
- 4 following:
- 5 "Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 6 Freedom to Be a Patriot Act.
- 7 Section 5. Display at State buildings. Display of the
- 8 flag of the United States may not be prohibited at any
- 9 building owned, leased, or otherwise controlled by the State
- 10 of Illinois.
- 11 Section 7. The Military Code of Illinois is amended by
- 12 adding Section 25.6 as follows:
- 13 (20 ILCS 1805/25.6 new)
- 14 <u>Sec. 25.6. Illinois Military Flags Commission.</u>
- 15 <u>(a) The Illinois Military Flags Commission is</u>
- 16 <u>established for the purpose of assisting the Adjutant General</u>
- 17 <u>with his or her responsibilities under Section 25 of this</u>
- 18 <u>Code</u>. The <u>Commission</u> shall advise the Adjutant General on
- 19 how to best collect, preserve, and present or display to the
- 20 public the colors, flags, quidons, and military trophies of

- 1 war belonging to the State in order to disseminate
- 2 <u>information relating to the history of the Illinois National</u>
- 3 Guard.
- 4 (b) The Commission consists of 15 members: the Adjutant
- 5 General, the State Historian, the Director of the Illinois
- 6 State Museum, and the Director of the Historic Preservation
- 7 Agency, all ex officio; 4 members of the General Assembly,
- 8 one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the
- 9 <u>Senate</u>, one by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one by the
- 10 Speaker of the House of Representatives, and one by the
- 11 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; and 7
- 12 residents of the State appointed by the Governor. When
- 13 appointing members to the Commission, the Governor must
- 14 <u>endeavor to appoint persons in a manner to maintain as</u>
- 15 <u>regionally diverse a membership as possible. Persons</u>
- 16 appointed to the Commission should provide it with experience
- in areas such as, but not limited to, knowledge of military
- 18 <u>history</u>, <u>particularly of the American Civil War</u>, and the
- 19 <u>education of citizens</u>. Any vacancy in the Commission shall
- 20 <u>be filled by an appointment in the same manner as the</u>
- 21 <u>original appointment. Members of the Commission shall serve</u>
- 22 <u>without compensation</u>, but shall be reimbursed for their
- 23 <u>reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their</u>
- 24 <u>duties</u>.
- 25 <u>(c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2006.</u>
- 26 Section 8. The Condominium Property Act is amended by
- 27 adding Section 18.6 as follows:"; and
- 28 below the last line of Sec. 103.30 in Section 10, by
- 29 inserting the following:
- 30 "Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 31 becoming law.".
