Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that the Department of Public Aid may not establish any formulary limits on, or restrict by any prior authorization requirement, any insulin prescription drug as prescribed and determined to be medically necessary for the treatment of diabetes. Effective July 1, 2004.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 adding Section 5-5.12b as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 5-5.12b.</u> Insulin; formulary limits; prior 8 <u>authorization.</u>

9 <u>(a) The Department of Public Aid may not establish any</u> 10 <u>formulary limits on, or restrict by any prior authorization</u> 11 <u>requirement, any insulin prescription drug as prescribed and</u> 12 <u>determined to be medically necessary for the treatment of</u> 13 <u>diabetes.</u> 14 <u>(b) The Department of Public Aid shall make all exemptions</u>

15and exclusions from formulary limitations and from prior16approval requirements identified in subsection (a) applicable17to all agencies, departments, and programs under its
