1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Child Care Act of 1969 is amended by changing Section 2.18 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 10/2.18) (from Ch. 23, par. 2212.18)
- Sec. 2.18. "Day care homes" means family homes which receive more than 3 up to a maximum of 12 children for less than 24 hours per day. The The number counted includes the family's natural or adopted children and all other persons
- under the age of 12. The term does not include facilities which
- 12 receive only children from a single household.
