The Automated Traffic Control Systems in 5 Highway Construction or Maintenance Zones Act is amended by 6 changing Sections 10 and 30 as follows: 7 (625 ILCS 7/10) Sec. 10. Establishment of automated control systems. 8 Department of State Police may establish an automated traffic 9 10 control system in any construction or maintenance zone established by the Department of Transportation or the Illinois 11 State Toll Highway Authority. - 22 (a) The vehicle, vehicle operator, vehicle registration 23 plate, speed, date, time, and location must be clearly visible

- 1 on the photograph or other recorded image of the alleged 2 violation.
- (b) A Uniform Traffic Citation must be mailed or otherwise 3 4 delivered to the registered owner of the vehicle. If mailed, 5 the citation must be sent via certified mail within $\frac{14}{6}$ business days of the alleged violation, return receipt 6
- 7 requested.

- (c) The Uniform Traffic Citation must include:
- (1) the name and address of the vehicle owner;
- (2) the registration number of the vehicle; 10
- (3) the offense charged; 11
- (4) the time, date, and location of the violation; 12
- (5) the first available court date; and 13
- 14 (6) notice that the basis of the citation is the 15 photograph or recorded image from the automated traffic control system. 16
- (d) The Uniform Traffic Citation issued to the violator 17 18 must be accompanied by a written document that lists the violator's rights and obligations and explains how the violator 19 20 can elect to proceed by either paying the fine or challenging 21 the issuance of the Uniform Traffic Citation.
