The Township Code is amended by adding Section 4 5 85-60 as follows: (60 ILCS 1/85-60 new) 6 7 Sec. 85-60. Lease of surplus real estate. If the township board of any township determines that any real estate acquired 9 10 11

by or held by the township is no longer necessary, appropriate, required, or profitable for the township or that leasing the real estate is in the best interest of the township, the township board may pass an ordinance authorizing the township to lease the real estate for a term not to exceed 40 years.

Passage of the ordinance shall require the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members of the township board. If the term of the lease under the proposed ordinance is 20 years or more, then the township board shall publish notice of its intent to adopt the ordinance at least once in a newspaper having general circulation in the township. The notice shall be published no more than 30 days and no less than 15 days before the date of the meeting at which the ordinance is proposed to be adopted and must contain an accurate description of the real estate, the purpose for which the real estate is used by the township,

and any restrictions upon the proposed use of the real estate.

- the lease, including authorizing the lessee to provide other 2
- public facilities in or on the real estate. The township board 3
- may contract with the lessee for the use of a portion of any 4
- structure or improvement to be constructed on the real 5
- 6 <u>estate.</u>".
