AN ACT concerning State Government.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Department of Natural Resources
(Conservation) Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois
is amended by adding Section 805-550 as follows:

8 Sec. 805-550. Electric scooters; State parks. The Department has the power to regulate the operation of electric 9 scooters in State parks. As used in this Section, "electric 10 scooter" means a device upon which a person may ride consisting 11 of a footboard between 2 end-wheels, controlled by an upright 12 steering handle attached to the front wheel, powered by an 13 electric driven motor, and capable of a maximum speed of no 14 15 more than 15 miles per hour on a flat surface. The Department shall allow the use of electric scooters on the paved roadways 16 17 within the State parks under the Department's jurisdiction, but may designate which roadways are suitable for these operations. 18 19 A person who operates or is in actual physical control of an electric scooter under this Section must be 16 years of age or 20 21 older. Nothing in this Section authorizes the use of electric scooters off-road in State parks under the Department's 22 23 jurisdiction.

24 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 25 becoming law.
