Except as otherwise provided in this Section, upon Upon request the State's 8 attorney of the county where the regional superintendent's 9 10 office is located shall act as the legal representative of the regional superintendent of schools; however, where matters 11

arise which are within the exclusive jurisdiction of another 12 State's attorney, said State's attorney shall provide legal 13 representation. If, in multicounty educational service 14 regions, the county boards grant approval through an 15 intergovernmental agreement, or if, in educational service 16

regions serving only one county, the county board grants 17

18 approval, then the regional superintendent of schools is

authorized to hire private legal counsel to represent him or 19

her in legal matters, and each county located within the region 20 shall pay a per capita share of the legal fees incurred, based

22 on the number of people in the county according to the most

recent U.S. census. 23
